The question is, are we ready to step out and trust God for His provision and leading? With this update, we’d hope to encourage you to partner up with us in preaching the gospel to nations.

## Jerusalem, Israel

In November 2016, our team visited King of kings Ministry in Jerusalem; we had a chance to fellowship with the key leaders, and truly we’re very honored to share this global mission platform with men and women of God in Israel. Our heart to bring the gospel back to Jerusalem is one step closer as we work with different mission-minded ministries around the world. Our goal is to establish Asia House of Prayer in Jerusalem through partnering up with ministries in USA, China and Israel.



## India

In January 2017 we sent our India mission coordinator, Andy to visit 2 outreach centers in northern India to encourage the leaders. However the main purpose of Andy’s visit was to comfort our pastor’s family because the outreach pastor passed away of heart attack. Pastor Sunelal served the Lord and His people faithfully; he had a tremendous encounter with Jesus, which became his life goal to save the lost. We will miss our brother in Christ, Sunelal.

Pastor Sunil is the son of pastor Sunelal. Sunil lost both his mother and father in 2016; it was extremely devastating and sorrowful for Sunil. After 3 months of mourning, Sunil has come back to the mission field serving people in villages and slums. Our team grieved and mourned with Sunil all this time; currently we are still collecting a love offering for him. Our teams in northern India have been actively reaching out on the streets, slums and villages. We train up young disciples and new believers to do one-on-one outreach, and encourage them to pray for the lost. The result has been very fruitful. Although these young people were persecuted verbally, their hearts stay strong for the Lord as they realize “the world will hate you because of the name of Jesus Christ.”

Rob and Joseph went to India with a mission to help establish God-centered private pre-schools in February. We strongly believe in “marketplace ministry” where God touches lives outside of church buildings. Through education, we would like to share the love of God with both children and parents in India.

## Senegal, West Africa

In March 2017, our team went to Senegal in west Africa to support the local mission bases. Other than sharing the gospel, we also hosted business/career seminars to train up kingdom-minded professionals and entrepreneurs. Everyone was inspired and challenged to develop business with a purpose. With a divine appointment, we were able to connect with missionaries from Hong Kong who are called to serve Chinese in Senegal. It is fascinating to see how God connects us with missionaries and African leaders to reach west and north Africa. Also we were invited to a gourmet Chinese restaurant in Dakar Senegal with fresh seafood! Hallelujah! Currently we have established 2 mission bases in Senegal, and we're raising up more ministry workers to reach Mali and Morocco by 2018.



## Vancouver, Canada

How do we reach out to young Chinese immigrants in Canada who probably would never walk into a church? How do we share Jesus with the millennials who are having everything served on a silver platter?

This is the challenge that God sets us up with in Vancouver, Canada. Through Rob, we are connected with these young Chinese immigrants who belong to an exotic sports car club. At dinner table, we started talking about spirituality and God; everyone was very engaging and interested to know more. It would seem like they have everything their money could buy, but deep inside they are yearning for more. At the end, one young man who believes in God wants to get baptized, and another wants to give his life to Jesus again. People are waiting for us to share God with them. Please pray for this marketplace outreach in Vancouver, we believe God is doing something amazing through this group.

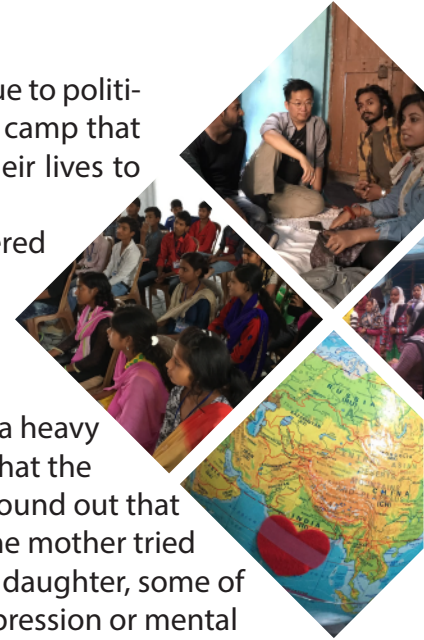
Shalom, friends and families

Jesus said, "All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth. Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all things that I have commanded you." Thus we seek to connect the like-minded to advance the Kingdom. In this newsletter, we bring you reports from current and new nations we have been working with.

## *India*

Recently many believers and churches in the northern India have been persecuted due to political and religious reasons. Regardless the hardship, our teams put together a 5 days camp that gathered around 40 young people. During the camp, many young people gave their lives to Jesus, and one girl was delivered from demonic possession. Hallelujah!

The most precious thing was when the Indian leaders from different ministries gathered and ministered to these young people together, that really demonstrates the love of God overcoming every difference.



**TESTIMONY:** As the USA mission team visited a family, we felt a heavy spiritual oppression at the house. The Lord revealed it to us that the mother of the house was ill, and we should pray for her. We found out that this family has been tormented by the spirit of suicide, and the mother tried to burn herself alive without knowing why. According to the daughter, some of their relatives committed suicide in the house because of depression or mental illness (we believe it was demonic possession). By God's power and grace, we prayed for the family to break off every curses and the spirit of suicide. The mother later shared with us that she felt something left her. Hallelujah! Praise God that they are still keeping their faith till today.

Christmas and New Year Celebration in 2017 was a time of harvest – Called to Nations sponsored an outdoor evangelistic crusade in the northern part of Uttar Pradesh. Hundreds of people came to hear the gospel, and many accepted Jesus as their Savior. Often I say, if you cannot serve as a short or long term missionary, then allow your money to serve as a missionary. Thank you for sending your support to the frontline of the mission field.

**BAPTISM:** In March after 21 days of fasting and prayer at a new outreach center in Madhya Pradesh, 3 people decided to get baptized and gave their life to God fully. 8 people received baptism during the Resurrection Sunday in April in Uttar Pradesh. Praise God that He continues adding to their number daily those who were being saved.
